Assembling a Bushing Storage Stand

The bushing storage stand is a simple way to keep the reusable bushings from various turning project kits organized and easy to find.



The kit includes:

- 15 plastic storage tubes with lids
- 4 large (2.5/8") legs
- 4 small (1.3/4") legs
- 8 screws
- 15 labels
- Top and bottom plates of stand

Instructions:

- 1. Remove all packaging from kit materials.
- 2. Select which legs you'd like to use.
- 3. Align each pre-drilled hole on the top plate of the stand with a leg. Insert the screws into the holes and tighten to attach the legs to the plate.
- 4. Flip the stand upside down and align the predrilled holes in bottom plate with the legs. Insert and tighten the remaining screws.
- 5. To label the bushing storage tubes, simply peel and stick the adhesive circles to the lids and write the bushing size or style on it.
- 6. Place the storage tubes into the holes of of the assembled bushing stand.

Options

- Use longer or shorter legs to make a tall or short stand.
- To create a tilted appearance, put long legs on one side and short on the other.
- To save even more space, mount the stand vertically on the wall.
